Colorful variety of retailers ensures high capacity utilization

- "Hugendubel" has taken over the "Lesezeichen" branch and expanded it with an attractive range.
- The popular "Bäckerei Schürmann" bakery has been supplying customers with fresh baked goods again since April as "Der Backfriese".
- The electronics store "Expert Bening" has completely rebuilt its store while it continues to operate and will be launching a fresh new concept just a few days after its anniversary.
- The "Gartencenter Ostmann", our direct neighbor, opened its doors in August, thus sustainably expanding and deepening the overall product range at the location.

"This means that the 'DollartCenter' is not only well equipped for the future, but is currently around 95% let. This is an excellent result, and yet we are always exploring the market for new trends and ideas to make the offering even more attractive," explains Michael Bünnagel, Head of Center & Property Management at Jagdfeld Real Estate.

New center manager is an East Frisian
