With a total of over 50 stores, 3,000 free parking spaces, optimal integration into the public transit network, and a direct connection to the B 169, “Riesapark” is a central destination for a large catchment area.

The “PEP Torgau” in Torgau, northern Saxony, serves as a retail hub for the 20,000 residents of this rural county seat and its surrounding area. The shopping center spans 30,000 m² and offers a diverse mix of retailers, including Kaufland, dm, and Obi, among others. “PEP Torgau,” which houses more than 30 stores, is easily accessible by car (600 parking spaces) and public transportation.
